Next month Costume Deposits will be due for the 2007 Recital in June.

These are due NO LATER than November 17th. Please do not bring these deposits in this month. If you plan

on adding a class, please make sure that you decide this by November 1. The costume deposit is \$30 per class your child is in. The remaining balance is then due in January when we get back from the break.

The total of the costumes usually runs between \$50-65 for each class. In December I order the costumes and pay for them in full, so once you have given me

a deposit, you are responsible for the remaining balance. If you have any questions about this process, please see the front desk.
