Costume Deposits

Costume Deposits are due by November 19th for the June recital. Your costume deposit is \$30 per class. This deposit is non-refundable.

Once I receive a deposit from you, in December I order the costumes and pay for them in full. Once you have given me a deposit, you are responsible for the remaining balance, which is Due

January 21.

I will have posters up when we get back from Christmas break with the pictures of all the costumes for you to see. The remaining balances will also be

on those posters.
